PREP

Malaysia

YEAR ONE

Malaysia is a country in Southeast Asia, situated just north of the Equator.

YEAR TWO

Malaysia is composed of two regions – West Malaysia and East Malaysia. The capital city of Malaysia is Kuala Lumpur.

YEAR THREE

Malaysia's population in 2020 was estimated at 32.7 million people. The people of Malaysia belong to a number of different races and religions. The largest group of Malaysians belong to three main races – Malays, Chinese and Indians.

YEAR FOUR

In West Malaysia the longest river is the Pahang River, and it is 434km long. The longest river in East Malaysia is the Rajang River, at 563km long. Both rivers flow year round due to the constant rainfall in Malaysia. Over time uncontrolled mining and agricultural activities have changed the natural setting of these rivers, which can cause problems during prolonged rain and flood events.

YEAR FIVE

The main food crop of Malaysia is rice, which is commonly grown on small farms. Over recent years there has been a decline in rice production, mainly due to unfavourable weather conditions and loss of farm labour to urban manufacturing jobs. Rubber and palm oil have become popular cash crop choices with Malaysia now being one of the world's top producers of palm oil. Other popular crop choices are cocoa, pepper, coffee, tea, various fruits and coconuts.

YEAR SIX

The country of Malaysia is self-sufficient in its energy production, with petroleum resources making up the major energy source for power generation.

The manufacturing industry has a major focus on producing goods for export. There has been rapid growth in the assembly of electronic equipment, electrical machinery, appliances, chemicals and textiles. The electrical and electronic products form the largest proportion of exported goods, however commodities like palm oil and rubber remain important also.

The rapid expansion in Malaysia's economy caused a large demand for additional labour in the manufacturing, construction and service sectors. Although this labour shortage attracted many workers from regional areas, companies still found it necessary to recruit foreign labour, mainly from Indonesia, the Philippines, Bangladesh and Thailand.
